I. Who are We?

II. Elocution Battle

The Elocution Battle is a single day Speech event ...

After the registration time ends, the topic for the battle will be released on the website and will also be informed via mail. The participants are then expected to present their views about the same, either for or against the topic. Views should be presented in the form of a speech as there will be no rebuttal rounds.

The entire event will be live-streamed on Youtube and hence we request each participant to go through the Rulebook thoroughly.

Participants will be evaluated on factors like sticking to the topic, the crispness of speech, factual correctness, and other factors to unveil the winning Orator amongst all.

III. Elocution Battle RULES

The battle rules are simple:

- Each speaker gets a set amount of time, 180 secs, to deliver his/her opening statement/speech/views and keep his/her points in favour or against the motion.
- Basic Flow of speech expected: Introduction, For/Against, Views.
- No rebuttals are allowed. Although participants can counterpoint other speakers in their speech.
- The language used should be legally acceptable and participants are requested to maintain the code of conduct of the event.
- In case of any objectionable or political remark, the participant will be disqualified and be debarred from further participation in any of the events.
- Participants will be evaluated on factors like sticking to the topic, the crispness of speech, factual correctness, and other factors to unveil the winning Orator amongst all.

Judging factors focus mainly on the following points:-

- Research and analysis of the participant on that particular topic
- The DNA of his/her speech and the uniqueness of their oratory.
- Rhetorics (minor)
- Fluency (minor)
- Ability to stick to the topic and keep points as close to the topic as possible.
